Course Description

Prerequisites: Successful completion of Biology and Algebra I (or equivalent) with strong academic performance **Course Overview**

Honors Chemistry is a rigorous, laboratory-based study of matter, energy, and the interactions that govern the physical world. Designed for highly motivated students with strong analytical and mathematical skills, this accelerated course develops a deep conceptual understanding of chemical principles while emphasizing quantitative problem solving, scientific inquiry, and evidence-based reasoning.

Students investigate the structure and properties of matter at the atomic and molecular levels and use scientific models to explain observable phenomena. Through laboratory experimentation, data analysis, and collaborative investigations, students learn to think and work like scientists while developing skills essential for advanced science coursework.

- Scientific measurement, uncertainty, and laboratory safety
- Classification and properties of matter
- Atomic structure and the history of atomic theory
- Electron configuration and periodic trends
- Chemical bonding and molecular geometry
- Chemical nomenclature and formula writing
- Chemical reactions and equation balancing
- The mole concept and stoichiometry
- States of matter and gas behavior
- Thermochemistry and energy transformations
- Solutions and concentration calculations

- Acids, bases, and pH
- Reaction rates and chemical equilibrium

- Analyze quantitative and experimental data.
- Use mathematical models to explain chemical phenomena.
